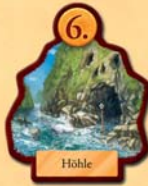
## Sites of Finds and Additional Directives

The directive at a site can be used by the player with the most figures at that site



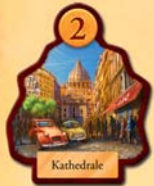
### 1. Ore Mines

Break a tie in your favor at another site.  
*Note: If you are involved in the tie, this gives you the majority at the other site.*



### 6. Cave

Swap one of your own fragments with one from the middle. *Note: Naturally, you are not allowed to look at the fragment from the middle beforehand. Then reshuffle the fragments in the middle.*



### 2. Cathedral

Move one of your figures 2 sites away from here.  
*Note: You can do this clockwise or counterclockwise.*



### 7. Cemetery

Put another player's fragment into the middle. *Note: You may look at all of this player's fragments of one color and pick one of them. Then reshuffle the fragments in the middle.*



### 3. Monastery

Look at all fragments of one site and swap one fragment with one from the middle.  
*Note: You swap with a fragment from the middle but you're not allowed to look at it. Then reshuffle the fragments in the middle.*



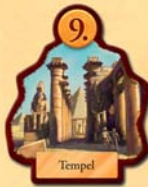
### 8. Ritual Site

Take a fragment from the player who has the most fragments. *Note: You are not allowed to look at the fragment beforehand, of course. If you yourself have the most fragments, don't use this directive. If two or more players have the most fragments, you may choose the player.*



### 4. Atlantis

Relocate another opponent's figure by one step.  
*Note: You can do this clockwise or counterclockwise.*



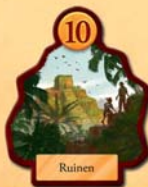
### 9. Temple

Swap one of your own fragments with that of another player. *Note: Of course, you are not allowed to look at the other player's fragment beforehand.*



### 5. Easter Island

Take a fragment from the middle.  
*Note: You are not allowed to look at the fragment beforehand, of course.*



### 10. Ruins

Only one figure at the site: Take away a fragment from another player. *You are not allowed to look at the fragment beforehand, of course. You can use this directive only if you have just one figure at the site and it is the only figure there.*
